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Our School

Randlay Primary School & Nursery is a 3 to 11 primary school situated in the south of Telford. We are fortunate to be ideally situated for local amenities such as Telford Town Park, the ice rink and Telford shopping centre, as well as having good transport links by being near to the bus station, railway station and local road networks.

We are the only school in the district of Randlay, drawing children from a diverse mixture of socio-economic backgrounds which serves the community. A large number of children travel from other parts of Telford to attend the school. There are currently 327 children on roll, plus 22 part-time pupils in the Nursery.

Accommodation and Staffing

In total there are 12 classbases, eight of which are in the main school building and four are within demountable classrooms. All classrooms have their own practical areas and interactive whiteboards or interactive touchscreens. The school has a hall/dining area, an ICT suite, library general purpose/resource room and is set in very attractive grounds with extensive field areas.

In addition to the headteacher staffing currently stands at 14 teachers. There are teaching assistants and special support assistants in each classbase, HLTAs, a school business manager and two clerical assistants.

There is an in-school breakfast club and an after school club which is maintained and run by an outside provider.

School meals are tendered out to Telford & Wrekin Council's Education Catering Services and are cooked on site. All cleaning arrangements are tendered out to Telford & Wrekin Council's Education Cleaning Service.
